### TEST YOUR TUTELAGE

When did the 10 Tribes of Israel become "lost"?

In Amos 9:9 Yahweh promises to sift Israel among the gentiles. In Luke 2:36, Anna, a prophetess from the (supposedly lost) tribe of Asher, prophesied about the infant Messiah in the Temple. Yahshua sent his disciples to "lost sheep of the house of Israel" on a missionary trip (Matt 10:6). One Apostle addresses his epistle to "the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad," James 1:1. Today, many followers of Yahshua believe they are Israelites. Though it's possible, proof will remain elusive until a strong foundation of DNA and historical data are established. Acts 1:6, Revelation 7:4, and Ezekiel 37:21 anticipate the restoration of Israel. Though they are not lost to Yahweh, the 10 tribes have been lost to history since the time of the Jewish historian, Josephus, who

mentions the innumerable 10 tribes of Israel as living beyond the Euphrates (Ant., Book XI Ch.5 Sect.2). Answer (D)

### Just the Facts

If two million Israelites took part in the exodus out of Egypt (a conservative estimate based on Numbers 1:45-46), the procession would have been an incredible sight. Marching 50 abreast, the column of departing sojourners would have stretched for 23 miles into the desert. Walking at a comfortable pace of 2.5 miles per hour, it would have required almost 10 hours for all to pass any one point.
