Passover and Feast of Unleavened Bread by Month's End?

With the start of the secular month of March our anticipation of the Passover grows with each week. Providing the new moon is confirmed on the 16th (or 17th) and the green barley ears are found at the time of sighting, the month of Abib will be declared and Passover and Feast of Unleavened



Bread will then come at the end of the month. (The entire Biblical calendar is linked on our home page at www.yrm.org.) If the barley is not ready (Abib) by the middle of this month, the yearly calendar will be delayed one month. We will be observing the Passover memorial service on the Biblical 14th of Abib and the entire week of Unleavened Bread with activities each day. In Genesis 15:18, Abram received this promise: "Unto your seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates." The Euphrates continues to flow and mark a boundary in Babylonian territory. The "River of Egypt" has been variously identified as the Wadi el Arish or the Pelusian arm of the Nile, which lay on Egypt's eastern border and has since disappeared. That location would make the Sinai Peninsula a part of the Covenant Promise, which is yet to be fulfilled in the Messianic era. Thus far the Israelites have consistently not proven themselves worthy to receive a fulfillment of that promise. Answer: (a)
